

ORDINANCE NO. 112

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE,
SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REPEALING ORDINANCE
NO. 6 OF SAID BOROUGH, ENACTED MAY 19, 1967, AND
PERMITTING HUNTING OF CERTAIN TYPES OF GAME WITHIN
THE BOROUGH LIMITS UNDER CERTAIN RULES AND
REGULATIONS AS SET FORTH HEREIN.**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County, Pennsylvania finds that it is necessary and desirable to permit limited hunting of certain game within the Borough limits and that such hunting will promote the general welfare of the residents of the Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 6 of the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, enacted May 19, 1967 which prohibited all hunting within the Borough limits, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The hunting of deer and wild geese within the Borough limits of the Borough of Indian Lake shall be permitted but only in accordance with the applicable statutes of the United States of America and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Game Commission, as enacted and promulgated

from time to time, and in accordance with the following hunting rules and regulations of the Borough:

(a) All hunters must comply with the rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Game Commission at all times. Violators will be prosecuted according to law.

(b) The hunting of geese in the Borough with shotguns shall be permitted, subject to the applicable Federal and Pennsylvania statutes, the rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Game Commission and these regulations.

(c) The hunting of deer with bow and arrow shall be permitted within the Borough limits, subject to the applicable Federal and Pennsylvania statutes, the rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Game Commission and these regulations.

(d) Hunters of deer and geese within the Borough limits are required to pre-register at the Borough office, at which time each hunter must provide his or her name, address, telephone number and Pennsylvania hunting license number and present his or her archery hunting license for the prior year.

(e) Hunting shall only be permitted on a day -to-day basis and, upon registration, each hunter will be issued a colored armband to show that he or she is permitted to hunt on the day specified for the color of his or her armband.

(f) The number of armbands (hunters) permitted each day will be determined by the Borough and permits will be issued on a first come first serve basis to qualified hunters.

(g) Hunters may only hunt in designated areas. Each hunter will receive a map showing such designated hunting areas at the time of registration.

(h) Before a hunter may kill a buck, he or she must first kill an antlerless deer.

(i) All deer killed by registered hunters must be gutted at the area designated for that purpose.

(j) Hunters shall return their armbands to the Borough office at the end of each day of hunting.

(k) Each hunter must register the number of geese and deer killed at the Borough office at the end of each hunting day.

(l) Baiting of deer and geese is prohibited and homeowners are prohibited from spreading corn or placing salt licks on their property in order to attract geese and deer.

SECTION 3. The rules and regulations set forth above in Section 2 of this Ordinance may be amended from time to time by the Borough Council.

SECTION 4. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance or the hunting rules and regulations set forth herein shall, upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than six hundred dollars (\$600.00) and the costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to be imprisoned for a period of not more than thirty (30) days.


SECTION 5. Any Ordinance or part of an Ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same is hereby repealed.
