

ORDINANCE NO. 133

BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING A STREET TO BE
KNOWN AS "INDIAN LAKE DRIVE" AS A PUBLIC
STREET OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE,
SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of
Indian Lake, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by
authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The following described street is hereby opened, dedicated and
ordained as a public street of the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County,
Pennsylvania:

Being a street or road extending from U.S. Route 30 through
lands of the Borough of Indian Lake to North Shore Trail in
the Borough, with a uniform width of 50 feet, as shown on the
survey and plan thereof prepared for the Borough by Musser
Engineering Inc, which is attached hereto, marked Appendix 1
and incorporated herein by reference.


SECTION 2. The aforesaid street shall hereafter be a public street of the Borough
of Indian Lake and shall be part of the system of public streets and roads of the Borough.

SECTION 3. The aforesaid street shall hereafter be known as Indian Lake
Drive.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Borough Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, 53 P.S. §§46731 and 46732, as amended.
