

ORDINANCE NO. 21

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1  
OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE KNOWN  
AS "MOTOR VEHICLE REGULATIONS" ADOPTED  
JANUARY 12, 1973

1. a. No motor vehicle, and no combination of which a motor vehicle is a part, shall, when operated on the streets and highways of the Borough of Indian Lake, have a gross weight exceeding ten (10) tons.

b. That any motor vehicle, and combination of which a motor vehicle is a part whose gross weight exceeds ten (10) tons may be granted permission to use the streets and highways of Indian Lake Borough provided that a special permit is requested and granted by the Borough Manager prior to entering into the Borough of Indian Lake.

c. The penalty for violation of this Ordinance shall be the penalty as set forth as penalty in Ordinance Number one of this Borough.
