

ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 30
ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE FOR THE OPERATION
OF THE SANITARY SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT
AND ESTABLISHING THE CUSTOMER RATES FOR
PLANT SEWAGE.

WHEREAS, on January 3, 1977, the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake enacted Ordinance No. 30 entitled "An Ordinance for the Operation of the Sanitary Sewage Disposal Plant and Establishing the Customer Rates for Plant Sewage"; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of that Ordinance was to provide for the operation at a sewage disposal plant in the Borough of Indian Lake by the Borough of Indian Lake and the establishment of user charges; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake has turned over the operation of that sewage disposal plant to the Lakewood Corporation; and,

WHEREAS, because the Borough is no longer operating said sewage disposal plant, Ordinance No. 30 is no longer necessary as an Ordinance of the Borough of Indian Lake.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, and it is hereby ordained by the Authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 30 of the Borough of Indian Lake entitled "An Ordinance for the Operation of a Sanitary Sewage Disposal Plant and Establishing the Customer Rates for Plant Usage" is hereby repealed.
