

ORDINANCE NO. 72

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS ON LOCAL HIGHWAYS AND ROADWAYS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, is authorized to regulate stop intersections on local highways and roadways situate within the boundaries of the Borough, pursuant to the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162, No. 81, 75 Pa. C.S.A. 6109(a) and 6124 (the "Act"); and,

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, has found it necessary to establish certain stop intersections on local highways and roadways within the boundaries of the Borough; and,

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 6109(b) of the Act, the action taken by the Borough Council must be undertaken by Ordinance.

BE IT ENACTED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION I: Title and Applicability.

A. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Indian Lake Borough Stop Intersection Ordinance".

B. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply only to local highways and roadways under the control of the Indian Lake Borough Council, and shall not apply to any highways or roadways which are under the control of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

SECTION II: Stop Signs and Other Traffic Control Signs and Devices.

Except where directed to proceed by a police officer or appropriately attired persons authorized to direct, control or regulate traffic, every driver of a vehicle approaching a stop sign shall stop at a clearly marked stop line or, if none, before entering a crosswalk on the nearest side of the intersection or, if none, then at the point nearest the intersecting highway or roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before entering. After having stopped, the driver shall yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian or to any vehicle in the intersection or approaching on another highway or roadway so closely as to constitute a hazard during the time the driver

is moving across or within the intersection or junction of highways and/or roadways.

SECTION III: Designation of Specified Places Where Stop and Stop Except Right Turn Signs Are to be Erected.

A. "Stop" signs shall be erected at the following intersections:

1. On Delaware Path at its intersection with South Shore Trail.
2. On Delaware Lane at its intersection with South Shore Trail.
3. On Cherokee Lane and Seneca Path at the intersection of those roads with South Shore Trail.
4. On Seneca Lane at its intersection with South Shore Trail.
5. On Wenatchee Path at its intersection with South Shore Trail.
6. On Cherry Lane at its intersection with South Shore Trail.
7. On Arapaho Lane at its intersection with South Shore Trail.

8. On Wenatchee Lane at its intersection with South Shore Trail.

9. On Kiowa Lane at its intersection with South Shore Trail.

10. On Chippewa Lane at its intersection with South Shore Trail.

11. On Ottawa Lane at its intersection with South Shore Trail.

12. On Pueblo Path at its intersection with West Shore Trail Extension.

13. On Comanche Lane at its intersection with West Shore Trail Extension.

14. On Comanche Path at its intersection with West Shore Trail Extension.

15. On Algonquin Path at its intersection with West Shore Trail Extension.

16. On Iroquois Lane at its intersection with Potomac Lane.

17. On Potomac Lane at its intersection with West Shore Trail.

18. On Iroquois Path at its intersection with West Shore Trail.

19. On Syracuse Lane at its intersection with West Shore Trail.

20. On Syracuse Path at its intersection with West Shore Trail.

21. On Navajo Lane at its intersection with West Shore Trail.

22. On Navajo Path at its intersection with West Shore Trail.

23. On Osage Lane at its intersection with West Shore Trail.

24. On West Shore Trail at its intersection with Legislative Route 55069.

25. On Dakota Lane at its intersection with Legislative Route 55069.

26. On North Shore Trail at its intersection with Legislative Route 55069.

27. On Sioux Path at its two intersections with North Shore Trail.

28. On Huron Path at its intersection with Sioux Path.
29. On Huron Lane at its intersection with Sioux Path.
30. On Ithaca Lane at its intersection with Sioux Path.
31. On Mohawk Lane at its intersection with North Shore Trail.
32. On Choctaw Lane at its intersection with North Shore Trail.
33. On Choctaw Path at its intersection with North Shore Trail.
34. On Peninsula Drive Extension at its intersection with North Shore Trail and Peninsula Drive.
35. On Cayuga Circle at its intersection with Peninsula Drive.
36. On Pawnee Lane at its intersection with Peninsula Drive.
37. On Fairway North Road at its intersection with Peninsula Drive.

38. On Point Circle Drive at its intersection with Peninsula Drive.

39. On Palmer Drive at its two intersections with Peninsula Drive.

40. On North Peninsula Drive at its two intersections with Peninsula Drive.

41. On Air Park Drive at its intersection with Peninsula Drive.

42. On Fairway East Road at its intersection with Peninsula Drive.

43. On Clear Path Run at its intersection with Fairway East Road.

44. On the westbound lane of that portion of Fairway East Road which runs in an East-West direction at its intersection with another part of Fairway East Road which runs in a North-South direction, said intersection being East of the intersection of Clear Run Path and Fairway East Road.

45. On the southbound lane of Fairway East Road at its intersection with Lincoln Entrance Road.

46. On Lincoln Entrance Road at its intersection with Fairway East Road.

47. On Christian Center Road at its intersection with Township Road 571.

48. On South Peninsula Drive at its intersection with Peninsula Drive.

49. On Clear Run Road at its intersection with Peninsula Drive.

50. On the Main Entrance Road at its intersection with Pennsylvania Route 160.

B. "Stop except right turn" signs shall be erected at the following intersections:

1. On Main Entrance Road at its intersection with Peninsula Drive and South Shore Trail.

2. On Peninsula Drive at its intersection with Main Entrance Road and South Shore Trail.

3. On South Shore Trail at its intersection with Peninsula Drive and Main Entrance Road.

4. On southbound lane of West Shore Trail Extension at its intersection with Township Route 569.

5. On northbound lane of Fairway East Road at its intersection with Lincoln Entrance Road.

C. Any changes or additions to the places where stop and stop except right turn signs are to be erected pursuant to the provisions of the Act shall be by Resolution adopted by the Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, as and when the same are deemed necessary.

SECTION IV: Violations.

Any violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be a summary offense under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and shall be punishable by commencement of an action brought before a District Magistrate having jurisdiction.

SECTION V: Repealer.

A. Any Ordinance or portion of any Ordinance inconsistent herewith is hereby specifically repealed.

B. If any provision of this Ordinance is ruled unconstitutional or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
