

RESOLUTION NO. 1994-2

WHEREAS, the Borough of Indian Lake desires to amend Ordinance No. 94 enacted July 10, 1001, effective August 1, 1991 which regulates the speed of vehicles on various Borough roads; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Indian Lake has undertaken a speed restriction study in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and more specifically 72 Pa.C.S.A. §3363; and

WHEREAS, the traffic study, dated October 1, 1993, as been presented to the Borough Council of Indian Lake for consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due consideration, review and examination, it is the desire of the Borough Council to accept the traffic study and authorize the adoption of an ordinance regulating the speed of vehicles on the Borough road known as South Shore Trail beginning at the intersection of Delaware Path and extending on South Shore Trail around and through The Northwinds Lodge and its ancillary improvements to the intersection of South Shore Trail and Peninsula Drive, a distance of .70 mile.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the Borough Council of Indian Lake as follows:

1. That the traffic study undertaken by the Borough of Indian Lake in accordance with 72 Pa.C.S.A. § 3363 is hereby accepted and adopted by the Borough.

2. That the Borough of Indian Lake shall authorize the preparation and adoption of an Ordinance of the Borough of Indian Lake regulating the speed of vehicles on the Borough road known as South Shore Trail beginning at the intersection of Delaware Path and extending on South Shore Trail around and through The Northwinds Lodge and its ancillary improvements to the intersection of South Shore Trail and Peninsula Drive, a distance of .70 mile in accordance with the aforesaid traffic study.
