AMENDING INDIAN LAKE WATER WORKS RESOLUTION NO. 10

WHEREAS, the Borough of Indian Lake has adopted the resolutions of the Indian Lake Water Authority; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of Indian Lake, by motion, shall from time to time set the rate for water service; and,

WHEREAS, as of the date of this Resolution, the assessments on certain properties remain unpaid; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough is authorized by law to collect said assessments by placing liens on the properties which have not yet paid the assessments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The proper officials of Indian Lake Borough are hereby authorized to take the necessary steps to enter liens of record in the Somerset County Courthouse against all properties which have not paid the assessment imposed by the Borough of Indian Lake for services provided by the Indian Lake Borough Water Works.
2. That all further actions necessary, convenient or proper for the collection of said assessments be performed by the Borough, and the expenditure of the necessary fees and costs therefor are hereby authorized, which costs and fees shall be imposed upon the party against whom the lien is entered.
