Indian Lake Property Owners:

Due to the significant rain event yesterday, notwithstanding the flooding that came with it, the lake is now full (rising the final 11 inches in a matter of hours). The lake is therefore officially re-opened to all permitted recreational activities to include power boating and PWC use (remember the speed limit is 40 mph). Please remember that there is a significant likelihood that you may encounter floating debris so all boaters are advised to exercise caution. If you see floating debris, please contact the police (preferably via e-mail - police@indianlakepa.us<<mailto:police@indianlakepa.us>>), the Borough Office (office@indianlakepa.us<<mailto:office@indianlakepa.us>>) and advise of the location. For those that are willing and wish to help, please drag the debris to an accessible and safe location for pickup by Borough maintenance personnel. The area near the public launch ramp is the best place.
