AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE MINING OF COAL OR OTHER MINERALS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, the carrying on of the business and activity of mining coal or minerals within the boundaries of the Borough of Indian Lake is deemed to be noxious and offensive to the inhabitants of said Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has determined that the prohibition of the carrying on of such business and activity is in the public interest and is expedient and necessary for the maintenance of the safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Indian Lake, and it is hereby ORDAINED and ENACTED by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1: The carrying on or conducting of any mining, excavation of minerals or coal by slope mining, shaft mining, strip mining, auger mining or by any manner or method through which coal and/or any other minerals are removed from the earth, are hereby prohibited within the boundaries of the Borough of Indian Lake.

SECTION 2: Any person, including any officer of any corporation, violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and upon conviction thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) or, imprisonment for not exceeding thirty (30) days, or, both.

SECTION 3: In addition to the criminal penalties provided aforesaid, the provisions of this Ordinance may be enforced against any violator by proceedings in equity for injunctive relief, upon being authorized by motion or resolution of Borough Council.

SECTION 4: All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances insonsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
