ORDINANCE NO. 139

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF INDIAN LAKE, SOMERSET COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE INDIAN LAKE BOROUGH SEWER ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 107, TO PROVIDE FOR THE MAXIMUM UTILIZATION OF THE BOROUGH SEWER SYSTEM BY PERMITTING MULTIPLE SALES OF SEWER CONNECTIONS TO A SINGLE PURCHASER AT A NEGOTIATED RATE.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, finds that it is in the public interest to promote the maximum utilization of the Borough sewer system by providing for the sale of multiple sewer connections to a single purchaser at a negotiated rate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Indian Lake, Somerset County, Pennsylvania, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by authority of the same, as follows:

1. Section 9 of the Indian Lake Borough Sewer Ordinance, Ordinance No. 107, enacted May 12, 1998, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence thereto:

In order to facilitate the maximum utilization of the Borough sewer system, the Borough Council shall have the authority to sell multiple sewer connections to a single purchaser at a negotiated rate lower than \$3,750.00 per connection, but not less than \$2,750.00 per connection.

2. In all other respects, the said Indian Lake Borough Sewer Ordinance, Ordinance No. 107, shall remain in full force and effect.
